

From the Pastor's Desk:

Pope Francis wrote in his decree calling for a Jubilee Year that the Season of Lent should be a significant time. Reflecting on the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy is a virtual pilgrimage through Holy Doors of our conscience. Lent, with its characteristics of prayer, fasting and almsgiving, is a unique time to focus on true acts of mercy that spring from the character of this season. Here are a few ways to be merciful during Lent:

Be merciful to your family members. Every family is going to have its struggles. We have disagreements with one another, express anger or impatience, and get hurt by family. Everyone, however, can work on being more merciful, especially in our speech. The way some family members talk to one another is disgraceful. The hurts are so long lasting that some people remember being demeaned and degraded by others in the family. Because we know one another so well our words cut to the bone and do severe damage. During Lent we should work to change this pattern. If we can't bring ourselves to speak words of love, then at least keep our mouths closed.

Be merciful in your judgments. We are so quick to pass judgment on one another and eager to express criticism. We often leave no room for human error or mistakes. Our air of superiority lacks any humility or humanity. Sometimes we fall into the trap of judging whole ethnic or religious groups. Often we violate the 8th Commandment and bear false witness against our neighbors. We announce or report things that aren't completely true or repeat things we have no right to share. Show mercy to others. The motto often invoked by Pope Saint John XXIII is a good guide: "Oversee everything. Overlook a lot. Criticize a little."

Be merciful with social media. This wonderful new technology is merciless. We have the ability to capture a "gotcha" moment and humiliate others. We hide behind screen names and write horrible comments about other people. Without any humility we feel the need to post "comments" as if every thought we've ever had deserves expression. Other human beings become objects: politicians, sports figures, entertainers, religious officials are all treated as if they are not human. These individuals have feelings, emotions and families. It's perfectly fine to disagree with someone; it is not ever fine to be rude or disrespectful. Show some mercy and compassion for the frail humanity of every person. Just because someone has a famous name or important position doesn't mean they aren't deeply affected by our merciless attitudes. Just because we have the ability to comment, doesn't mean we should.

But now you must put them all away: anger, fury, malice, slander, and obscene language out of your mouths. Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another, if one has a grievance against another; as the Lord has forgiven you, so must you also do. And over all these put on love. (Colossians 3)

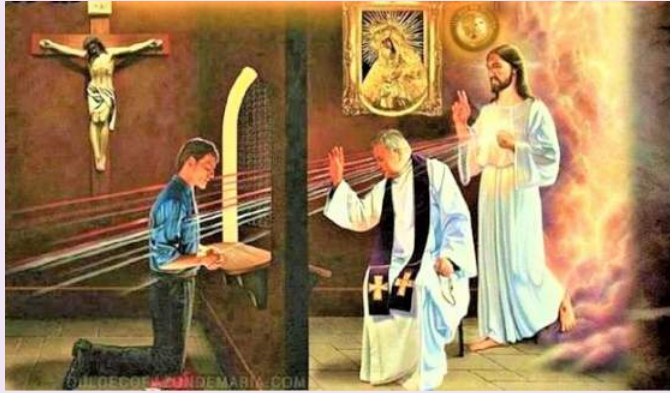
Parish St. Joseph Statue

THE SEASON OF LENT ST. ROCCO'S CHURCH

A GUIDE TO CONFESSION

BEFORE YOU GO: Examine your conscience, that is, reflect on what sins you've committed. To guide you, just Google "*examination of conscience*" and you'll find resources to help you. It's even all right to make a list to bring with you if that helps.

INTRODUCTION: When you come before the priest, begin by making the Sign of the Cross (praying the words out loud), and continue by saying, "*Bless me, Father, I have sinned. It has been (how long) since my last confession. These are my sins ...*"

CONFESSION: List the sins you've committed that came to mind during your examination of conscience. Don't be too general ("I haven't been a good person"), but a lot of detail isn't necessary (you don't need to tell the whole story of how a sin came about). If you're not sure if something is a sin, ask the priest. This isn't counseling, so unless you ask, the priest likely won't give you advice. He'll just move on to ...

PENANCE: The priest will suggest something for you to do or pray as a response to God's mercy. You'll have to remember what this is and do it after the confession is over, so pay attention.

ACT OF CONTRITION: The priest will then ask you to pray out loud your "Act of Contrition," to demonstrate your sorrow for your sins.

ABSOLUTION: Don't get up to leave after that prayer, because the best part is yet to come: The priest will extend his hands in your direction and he will pray the Prayer of Absolution: "*God, the Father of Mercies, through the death and resurrection of his Son, has reconciled the world to himself and poured out the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins. Through the ministry of the Church, may God grant you pardon and peace. And I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.*" You respond: "*Amen.*"

CONCLUSION: The priest will then likely say something like, "*God has freed you from your sin. Go in Peace.*" To which you can respond: "*Thanks be to God.*" Don't forget to do your penance. If it is saying certain prayers, it's best to do it right away in the church before you forget.

pre-k 4B

It has been a busy few weeks in Pre-K 4B! We have learned a lot about Dental Health and Space during our last few thematic units. The class particularly loved everything that we learned about our solar system!

During morning meeting, we have been working on writing/recognizing numbers 1-20, ordering numbers from least to greatest, and solving equations. We are diligently practicing writing our full names and learning various color words. In our phonics lessons, we are focusing on phoneme isolation, which includes identifying sounds at the beginning, middle, and end of words. Additionally, we are working on substituting and deleting initial phonemes. Our class has been doing an excellent job of producing the sounds for each letter and blending sounds to form words. We have started using 'Story Sticks' after reading books in class. These sticks help us determine the setting, problem/solution, characters, and key details. We have been also answering critical thinking questions after readings.

We have planted our own marigolds, which we will care for and take home when they are ready. We also can't wait to receive our classroom caterpillars in the next few weeks.

It's going to be a fun Spring in Pre-K!
