***From the Pastor's Desk:***  
**Feast of the Holy Family**

As we continue our celebration of the great Solemnity of Christmas, this weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family. Just a few days after Christmas we are reminded that the Son of God, the child Jesus born among us, grew up as a member of a human family. If we take a moment to read and reflect on the Gospel carefully we will see that the Holy Family, just like any other family, had their share of troubles and difficulties which caused them great worry and anxiety. And through it all, St. Joseph showed a father's courageous and protective instinct as he did his best to shield the Holy Family from hostility and from the forces of evil. When he learned in a dream of Herod's plot to kill the baby Jesus, he quickly uprooted Mary and the child and left that very night for Egypt where they would live in exile until the proper time to return their homeland and to their family.

The most elementary Christian community of our lives is the family into which we are born. The purpose of this Feast of the Holy Family is to show the importance and the sacredness of the family as the basic unit of church life. This Feast provides for us an opportunity to reflect on the quality of our homes and of our family lives, in so far as they imitate the values of the Holy Family of Nazareth. Family life is definitely a full time job which is not so much about parents and children living under one roof as it is about their hearts beating in harmony and love.

All this will happen if the message of Christ, in its richness, is found within the walls of the home. Mothers and fathers teach their children how to love and to be loved by word and example. Those families who avoid signs of mutual affection and don't show or teach tenderness can hardly complain if their homes turn out to be empty of love and warmth. Such households are not families, but rather a group of people sharing living accommodations. It's almost certain that conflicts, tensions and misunderstandings will emerge when people live in such close confines; patience, forgiveness, and fortitude are virtues which need to be stressed and worked on constantly.

Something else that is very important about family life is that, no matter how old or young children may be, the home should be the place where they feel free to talk about their troubles, their difficulties, and their accomplishments. Time should be spent listening to one another's problems and listening to one another's visions and dreams. Especially in our day and age mothers and fathers need to be the first teachers of their children in the ways of the Faith and the difference between right and wrong. Handing on the Faith means handing on a way of life. This Feast of the Holy Family is a reminder to us that Jesus came down to this earth to make a place for each and every one of us in His Father's family, so let us pray to the Holy Family that we may imitate their love, their devotion, and especially their faith.

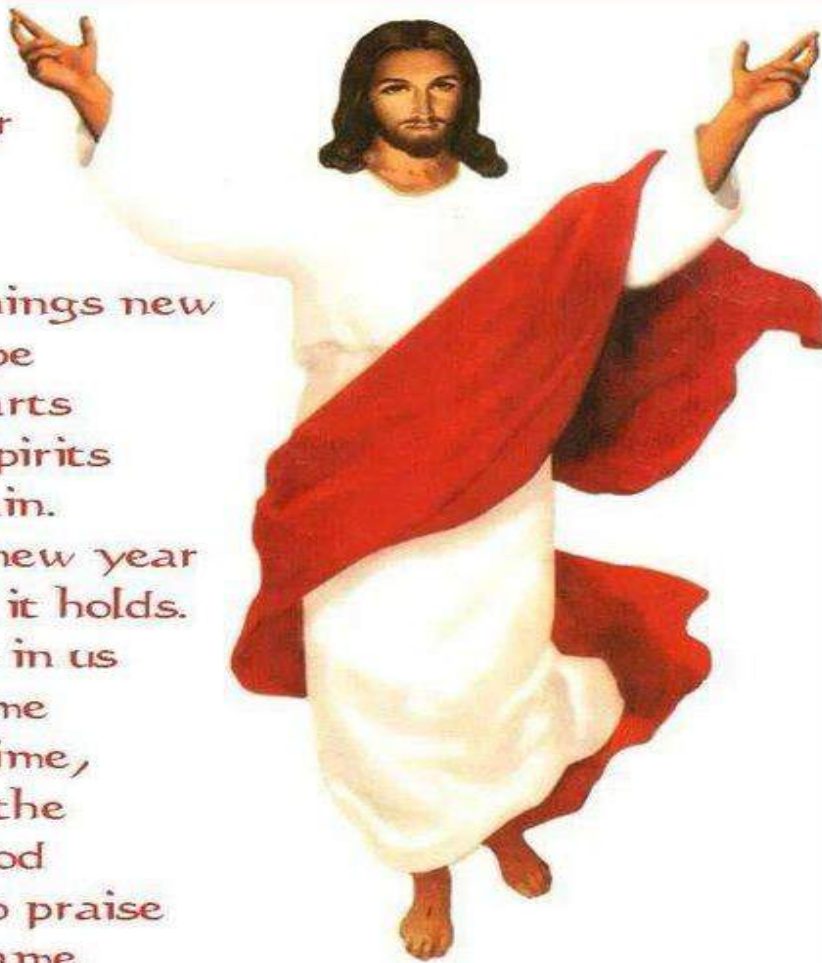

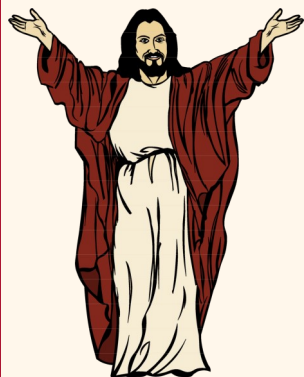
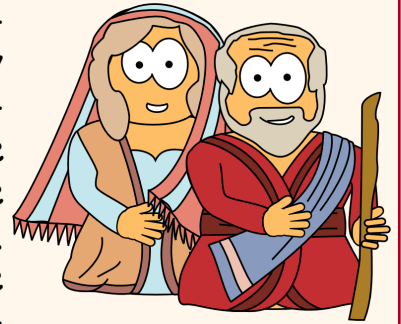
