## From the Pastor's Desk:

There are many different biblical verses you can meditate on during Lent, but one that could be especially helpful was suggested by Pope Benedict XVI in 2007. He picked a single verse that he wanted to focus on during the entire season of Lent:

*They shall look on him whom they have pierced.*  
John 19:37

Pope Benedict XVI then explains his choice and how it can help us focus during Lent:

"This is the biblical theme that this year guides our Lenten reflection. Lent is a favorable time to learn to stay with Mary and John, the beloved disciple, close to him who on the Cross, consummated for all mankind the sacrifice of his life (cf. Jn 19: 25). With a more fervent participation let us direct our gaze, therefore, in this time of penance and prayer, at Christ Crucified who, dying on Calvary, revealed fully for us the love of God."

Even though the verse he selected was very short, it can sustain our spiritual life with a great wealth of spiritual reflection. He continues his meditation on this passage, focusing on the love we should experience when we look at Jesus on the Cross:

"Dear brothers and sisters, let us look at Christ pierced on the Cross! He is the unsurpassing revelation of God's love, a love in which *eros* and *agape*, far from being opposed, enlighten each other. On the Cross, it is God himself who begs the love of his creature: He is thirsty for the love of every one of us."

Whenever we feel disconnected from the Lenten season, let us look up to Jesus on the Cross and experience His love washing over us.

## THE SEASON OF LENT ST. ROCCO'S CHURCH

### Why do Catholics cover crucifixes and statues during Lent?

It seems strange during the most sacred time of year Catholics cover everything that is beautiful in their churches, even the crucifix. Shouldn't we be looking at the painful scene at Calvary while we listen to the Passion narrative on Palm Sunday?

While it may appear counterintuitive to veil statues and images during the final weeks of Lent, the Catholic Church recommends this practice to heighten our senses and build within us a longing for Easter Sunday. It's a tradition that

shouldn't only be carried out in our local parish, but can also be a fruitful activity for the "domestic church" to practice. The rubrics can guide us. In the Roman Missal we find the instruction, *"In the Dioceses of the United States, the practice of covering crosses and images throughout the church from the fifth Sunday of Lent may be observed. Crosses remain covered until the end of the Celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday, but images remain covered until the beginning of the Easter Vigil."*

Families are also encouraged to imitate this practice and veil prominent religious images in their homes. It helps us to participate in the liturgical season, especially if we are prevented from going to Mass during the week. Otherwise we only see the veiled images in church once or twice before Easter and it has a minor effect on us. It's also a beautiful tradition to pass down to our children, who will be intrigued by it and will make this time of year truly special for them. We go through great lengths to decorate our homes for Easter, so why not prepare for the great feast by using veils?

But why go through such lengths to cover up images that are designed to raise our hearts and minds toward heaven? First of all, we use veils to alert us of the special time we're in. When we walk into church and notice everything is covered, we immediately know something is different. These last two weeks of Lent are meant to be a time of immediate preparation for the Sacred Triduum and these veils are a forceful reminder to get ready. Secondly, the veils focus our attention on the words being said at Mass. When we listen to the Passion narrative, our senses are allowed to focus on the striking words from the Gospel and truly enter into the scene. Third, the Church uses veils to produce a heightened sense of anticipation for Easter Sunday. This is further actualized when you attend daily Mass and see the veils each day. You don't want them to be there because they are hiding some very beautiful images. And therein lies the whole point: the veils are not meant to be there forever. The images need to be unveiled; it's unnatural for them to be covered.

The unveiling before the Easter Vigil is a great reminder of our own life on earth. We live in a "veiled" world, in exile from our true home. It's only through our own death that the veil is lifted and we are finally able to see the beauty of everything in our lives.

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### Classroom News.. Mrs. Lisa Scotti Kindergarten A



Happy Lent! Kindergarten A has been very busy this winter and we're so happy the weather has improved, giving us more outside time! We are no longer just out of Pre-K – we are headed toward First Grade!

Lent has been a major focus in our classroom, where we are learning about Lent as the season to “pull our weeds and plant good seeds”. We have made watering cans and seed packets for our bulletin board, and we've spoken about the good seeds we want to plant inside ourselves to replace the weeds we want to replace.

The children are making great strides in Reading by learning sight words and creating rudimentary sentences. Because First Grade is just around the corner, our Center play is now all about reinforcing phonics, numbers and cognitive skills.

As well, the children are excelling at Kindergarten Math. They are working with ten frames, at basic addition, patterns, grouping and writing equations. In keeping with numbers, every morning we practice saying and writing the “date in words and the date in numbers”.



Together, we are really making an effort to behave as First Graders. In fact, we have already learned to pray at the end of lunch, instead of going back to class. Getting along with each other, problem solving with peers and not shouting out are skills we will have down by June. First Grade, we're almost ready!

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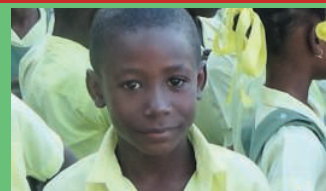
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
