From the Pastor's Desk:

Lent offers us the time to focus on our spiritual life and grow closer to God. However, it's a lot easier to experience a rewarding Lenten period if you get inspiration from some of the Church's numerous holy men and women. The life of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, who is set to be canonized during the Jubilee of Youth from July 28 to August 3, 2025, is one that can offer profound inspiration. Frassati's brief yet impactful life exemplifies virtues that can enrich our Lenten practices and family dynamics.

Embracing Sacrifice With Joy

Despite his affluent upbringing, Pier Giorgio chose a life of modesty, often giving away his possessions to those in need, even the shoes off his feet. He approached fasting not as a burden but as a joyful opportunity, frequently inviting friends to join him in these spiritual exercises. Families can draw from his example by embracing sacrifices during Lent with a positive spirit, transforming challenges into shared growth experiences.

Commitment to Service

Frassati dedicated much of his time to serving the poor and sick in his community, often bringing food, comfort and companionship to those in need. By embodying a hands-on approach to charity and engaging in acts of service together, families can strengthen bonds and cultivate empathy, making service a cornerstone of their Lenten observance.

Deepening Prayer Life

Known for his profound love of prayer, Pier Giorgio often spent hours in contemplation and participated in retreats and devotions. He would actually wake up early to attend Mass and then spend hours in prayer each day. During Lent, he intensified his prayer life by participating in Lenten retreats and devotions, such as the Stations of the Cross. Families can be inspired to deepen their prayer life during Lent, finding moments for collective reflection and spiritual connection.

Balancing Humor and Humility

Despite his noble lineage and academic achievements, Pier Giorgio remained humble and approachable. He would often use humor to lighten the mood and bring joy to those around him. In fact when the young Italian was hours away from death, he didn't wish to make a fuss as his grandmother had just passed away. Families might emulate this balance, fostering environments where faith and joy coexist harmoniously.

Courageous Advocacy

Pier Giorgio fearlessly lived out his faith in a secular world, standing up for the rights of workers and the dignity of every human person....

2025 GUIDELINES FOR LENT**

**How the Stations of the Cross are a Physical,  
Mental and Spiritual Exercise**

Over the centuries, Roman Catholics have continually turned to the Stations of the Cross as a way to live through Jesus' passion during the Lenten season. However, modern Catholics don't always see the benefits of the traditional devotion, a problem Dr. Edward Sri seeks to address in his new *Pocket Guide to the Stations of the Cross* published by Ascension Press. Sri has composed his own short meditations that cover both the traditional 14 stations most Catholics know, as well as the newer scriptural stations that were introduced by St. John Paul II. He also points out how the Stations of the Cross are a physical, mental and spiritual exercise.

**Physical** ~ One of the unique aspects of the Stations of the Cross is how *physical* it can be, especially when it's done outside of a church, walking from station to station. Sri explains how, "*We move, stop, make the Sign of the Cross, kneel, stand again, listen, and reply. All the moving, stopping, falling to our knees, and rising up again as we trace the Sign of the Cross over our bodies recalls Jesus on his way to Calvary.*" The physical aspect of the Stations are an important part of this devotion, reminding us of the many physical pains Jesus endured.

**Mental** ~ In addition to being a very physical devotion, Dr. Sri points out how it is also a *mental* exercise. Our mind reflects on what Jesus reveals in each station. We see an image related to each station in a book or on the church walls. We hear the leader read a reflection on the scene. All this helps fill our minds with the truth of what Jesus did for us on this day.

**Spiritual** ~ Last, but not least, the Stations are a *spiritual* exercise, designed to penetrate the depths of our soul. Sri explains how, "*We know we have prayed the Stations well when the devotion facilitates a deeper personal encounter with Christ—when we are drawn to love and sacrifice more, when we are stirred to tell Jesus we are sorry and repent of a certain sin, and when we more deeply realize his amazing love for us.*" The goal of the devotion is to unite us more closely to Jesus Christ and reflects the spiritual nature of the Stations.



### Classroom News.. Mrs. Michelle Rossner KB



My students in Kindergarten have been very busy learning about the virtue of charity during Religion class. I said that charity is helping people in need. The children discussed seeing homeless people on their way home. They mentioned they were sad seeing people without anything and wanted to help them.

Two children shared that we should buy items to help them. We decided to collect items and toiletries to make care packages and to help the St Vincent De Paul society.

The children watched a video about St Vincent De Paul and learned that he was dedicated to helping the poor. The kindergarteners worked together to put the care packages together to help the poor. St. Vincent De Paul visited our school and the children gave the items to them.

The students in the Kindergarten B class are making great progress in literacy and in reading. They have learned how to read over fifty sight words and are able to read small books in our ELA reading center. They have learned about short and long Ee sounds and about prefixes and about many words with blends. We have guided reading time three times a week.

The children are growing in their mathematics skills too. They are learning about making sets of thirty, forty, fifty. We count to one hundred everyday. They can do basic addition and are able to do basic measurement and have learned about making estimates.



Our Science this week was an experiment called "Fizzy Water". We added food coloring, alka seltzer, water and mixed it. The children learned that alka seltzer releases carbon dioxide gas and causes the water to fizzy and create bubbles. One student commented that the bubbles move fast from the movement of the water. They drew pictures of their observations.

My students have grown so much this year and the children love to learn each day. I can wait to see what they will do next by the end of the year.
