**From the Pastor's Desk:**

The Scriptures reveal God's words and actions, not only for the past, but for today as well. What God said through the Prophets of the Old Testament is still being said to us today. What happened to St. Peter in the Gospel has happened to all of us in our own lives whether we realize it or not.

St. Peter was a fisherman, not for sport, but for his livelihood. He and his partners had worked hard all night, but had caught nothing. Then Jesus, *the carpenter*, told Peter, *the fisherman*, to lower the nets again. The issue: it was midday, the worst time for fishing. We can hear the protest in Peter's voice: "*Master, we have worked hard all night and have caught nothing.*" He was at the point of telling Jesus to forget it when he realized to whom he was speaking. After a pause, perhaps while looking at Jesus and seeing the insistence in His eyes, Peter said, "*But at your command, I will lower the nets.*"

At this time Peter's faith wasn't strong, but it was strong enough for him to put emphasis on the "*you*" when he said, "*At your command, I will lower the nets.*" The result of Peter's trust in the Lord was an astonishing catch of fish. Peter thought his way best, but he learned otherwise. I think most of us realize the same thing eventually, but, more often than not, we learn it the hard way.

Our 1st and 2nd Readings also give us good examples on how putting our trust in God is best. The Prophet Isaiah at first didn't want to accept the mission of being a prophet to God's people. He felt unworthy. He described himself as a man of "*unclean lips.*" But God wanted him. In the account, Seraphim touched Isaiah's lips and He responded: "*Here am I lord, send me.*" That touch is a symbol of God's grace and how it can work in our lives. Isaiah became one of the greatest of all the prophets because he followed God's way.


St. Paul began by persecuting Christians. He felt this was the right thing to do. But God had other plans for him. God wanted St. Paul to be an Apostle and one of the authors of the New Testament Letters. He put into writing some of our most important doctrines; he traveled throughout the Mediterranean establishing churches in Antioch, Greece, Italy and as far as Spain. St. Paul is one of the most quoted authors of all time. God's way was better for St. Paul.

The challenge that faced Isaiah, St. Peter and St. Paul is the same challenge we face today; detecting the voice of God in our lives and answering generously. All three of these accounts offer us inspiring examples on how to put our trust and faith in God. Inevitably, during life there will be times when we are called to take a new direction and face the unknown, but we need not fear because with God what we think is impossible becomes possible.

We may not get a great catch of fish, and perhaps things seem to go wrong for us, but it's then we need to be patient and give God time to act. We can look to Isaiah's vision of Heaven and proclaim with him, "*Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might. Heaven and earth are full of your Glory.*" That expression of God's glory should remind us that God's ways are always the best ways.

***Our Lady of Lourdes  
Feast: February 11th***

On December 8, 1854, Pope Pius IX proclaimed the dogma of the Immaculate Conception in the apostolic constitution *Ineffabilis Deus*. A little more than three years later, on February 11, 1858, a young lady appeared to Bernadette Soubirous. This began a series of visions. During the apparition on March 25, the lady identified herself with the words: *“I am the Immaculate Conception.”*

Bernadette was a sickly child of poor parents. Their practice of the Catholic faith was scarcely more than lukewarm. Bernadette could pray the Our Father, the Hail Mary and the Creed. She also knew the prayer of the Miraculous Medal. During interrogations Bernadette gave an account of what she saw. It was *“something white in the shape of a girl.”* She used the word *“aquero”*, a dialect term meaning *“this thing.”* It was *“a pretty young girl with a rosary over her arm.”* Her white robe was encircled by a blue girdle. She wore a white veil. There was a yellow rose on each foot. A rosary was in her hand. Bernadette was also impressed by the fact that the lady did not use the informal form of address (tu), but the polite form (vous). The humble virgin appeared to a humble girl and treated her with dignity.

Through that humble girl, Mary revitalized and continues to revitalize the faith of millions. People began to flock to Lourdes from all over the world. In 1862 Church authorities confirmed the authenticity of the apparitions and authorized Our Lady of Lourdes. The Feast became worldwide in 1907. Lourdes has become a place of pilgrimage and healing, but even more of faith. Church authorities have recognized over 60 miraculous cures, although there have probably been many more. To people of faith this isn't surprising; it's a continuation of Jesus' healing miracles—now performed at the intercession of His mother.

Many who visit Lourdes return home with renewed faith and a readiness to serve God. There still may be people who doubt the apparitions of Lourdes. Perhaps the best that can be said to them are the words that introduce the film *Song of Bernadette*: **“For those who believe in God, no explanation is necessary. For those who do not believe, no explanation is possible.”**

**Prayer to Our Lady of Lourdes:** *Oh ever immaculate Virgin, Mother of Mercy, Health of the Sick, Refuge of Sinners, Comfortess of the Afflicted, you know my wants, my troubles, my sufferings. Look upon me with mercy. When you appeared in the grotto of Lourdes, you made it a privileged sanctuary where you dispense your favors, and where many sufferers have obtained the cure of their infirmities, both spiritual and corporal. I come, therefore, with unbounded confidence to implore your maternal intercession. My loving Mother, obtain my request. I will try to imitate your virtues so that I may one day share your company and bless you in eternity. Amen.*
