From the Pastor's Desk:

When we hear of holy kings and queens, usually they lived long ago. Saints like Queen Margaret of Scotland, Queen Elizabeth of Hungary, and King Louis IX of France lived nearly 1,000 years ago, and the stories handed down to us about their lives are steeped in distant, misty legends of the courtly age. But it turns out that some inspiring saintly royals lived in the modern era of trains, cars, and movies. One famously very holy royal couple lived in the 20th century, one of them until 1989.

Perhaps you've heard of Blessed Charles of Austria and Servant of God Zita of Bourbon-Parma. The last emperor and empress of Austria, they lived lives of heroic virtue during a tumultuous time. They were married for only eleven years before Charles died in 1922, but in that time they gratefully welcomed eight children, whom Zita would go on to raise alone. She lived for 67 years after her husband died, and wore black to honor his memory until his death.

Charles and Zita were an extraordinary couple by any measure, and their marriage in particular was a model for Christian couples. The day after their wedding, Charles told Zita, "*Now, we must help each other to get to Heaven.*" Honoring their vocation to marriage, the Church chose for their feast day not the dates on which they died, but their wedding day: October 21, 1911. When they entered into the marriage covenant on their wedding day, they chose to "*die to self*" every day of their lives. In honor of saintly Catholic royals Charles and Zita, here are 2 ways to honor their legacy today.

PRAY FOR YOUR SPOUSE

Charles and Zita were deeply devout Catholics, and prayed for each other throughout their love story. Taking a little time to pray for our spouses is a way to imitate their holy marriage. We can especially ask for their prayers for all married couples.


DO SOMETHING SPECIAL FOR YOUR FAMILY

The couple were devoted not only to each other but also to their children. They were thoughtful and generous parents to their lively brood. In fact, Charles contracted the illness that led to his death while he was on an errand to purchase toys for his children. A beautiful way to honor them today would be to do something special for your family or children.

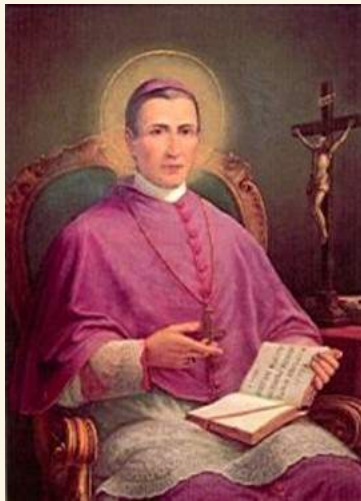

### St. Anthony Gianelli      *Mass: October 23rd*

Anthony Gianelli was born on Easter Sunday, April 12, 1789 in Cerreta, a tiny mountain-top village in Northern Italy. His parents gave him a priceless spiritual heritage, but they had nothing in the way of this world's goods to offer him. It was through the charity of their landlady that Anthony was able to enter the seminary and study for the priesthood.

When Anthony reached school age, his parents made the very difficult decision to send him to school which was four kilometers away. He always went on foot. He carried the shoes in his hands because he did not want to ruin them. On his way back, he would pick up sticks for the fire place which warmed up their poor home.

He was ordained priest on May 24, 1812, when he was only 23. After his ordination, he became the Pastor of Chiavari. While he was there, he used to see many young girls roaming the streets. His heart went to them. In visiting the hospital and the school of the city, he also noticed that the sick people and the young students were not receiving the care they needed. He came to the realization that the needs of Chiavari were great and that he needed dependable help to meet those needs. Thus, on January 12, 1829, he organized a Congregation of twelve young women willing to dedicate themselves completely to the Glory of God and the good of others. The house in which this Congregation began was near the basilica of Our Lady of the Garden, and so on the first day of its life, the Founder called it **The Daughters of Our Lady of the Garden**. From that day on, dedicated women, spread out in the five continents, have never failed to carry on the mission entrusted to them by their Founder in teaching, nursing, social and pastoral work and helping all those in need.

On October 1837, Anthony Gianelli was named Bishop of Bobbio. He could hardly believe that he, a peasant boy from the mountains, was to become a successor of the Apostles. But he humbly accepted the call and for seven years he gave himself heart and soul to the people of his diocese, instructing the seminarians, guiding the nuns, hearing confessions and performing countless works of charity for the poor. Although his energy seemed bound-less, the long days of work and the sleepless nights of prayer took a toll on his body. On June 7th, 1846, he left the sufferings of this world for the glory of heaven. Anthony was only 56 when he died. He died young, worn out by his work, but in that short span he accomplished a remarkable amount of good for the Church. Pope Pius XII declared him a saint on October 21, 1951.

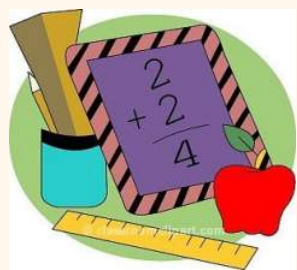
## **Classroom News ~ Miss Danielle Messier Grade 1**
